

CHANGING SCHOOL CHOICES FOR HSPT[®] SCORE REPORTING

School order choices cannot be changed. Reports will be sent to schools in the order they were selected on the test document. If you want to change the order, call the schools affected and indicate the changes to them.

ADDING ADDITIONAL SCHOOLS FOR HSPT[®] SCORE REPORTING

If you want to add additional schools to receive score reports you must:

- Call the school where you want the reports sent.
- Ask them to request the scores from the Archdiocese of Newark or the Diocese of Paterson, depending on where the school is located. Albertus Magnus should request scores from The Archdiocese of Newark.
- There may be a charge for this service.
- See score distribution policy below.

HSPT[®] SCORES DISTRIBUTED TO COOP-PARTICIPATING HIGH SCHOOLS ONLY

The names of the high schools that participate in the Cooperative Admissions Program (COOP) are listed in the COOP Student Handbook on pages 12-13 and on the njcoopexam.org welcome page. Students applying to high schools that are part of the COOP program must take the HSPT[®] in November. As part of the registration fee, HSPT[®] results for students testing through the Cooperative Admissions Program will be shared directly with up to three COOP-participating schools. Scores from the HSPT[®] taken as part of the cooperative admissions process **will not** be distributed to schools that are not part of the Cooperative Admissions Program. Parents of students who are applying to schools that are not part of the Cooperative Admissions Program should check with the school's admissions staff regarding testing requirements. Parents of students who take the HSPT[®] as part of the Cooperative Admissions Program in November will receive a HSPT[®] Student Score Report in early January, 2022. The report can be shared with non-participating schools if they will accept the results.
